APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Submit this application form and enclosed activities resume.
2. Submit letter of recommendation from the advisor of the activity in which the student holds an **elected position**.
3. Submit an **official** academic transcript.
4. Submit an essay of no longer than 250 words on the following topic: What personality trait that you possess has been the biggest asset to you in leadership situations?
5. Ten finalists will be notified by November 1 and will be scheduled to take a government-based current events test and be interviewed in Harrisburg on Saturday, November 21, 2009. Candidates who are not notified by November 1st can assume that they have not been selected as a Senate Youth state finalist.

RULES

1. Only **one** applicant can be accepted from each Pennsylvania secondary school.
2. The student must hold an elected office in student council, class government, or civic or educational organization. (Officers and representatives are included.)
3. The student must be a member of the junior or senior class during the 2009-2010 academic year and a resident of Pennsylvania.
