

District 10 Advisor of the Year Guidelines

In order to promote a smooth and equitable process for the selection of the District 10 Advisor of the Year, the following procedure has been established by the District 10 Board of Directors.

1. A nomination form for the Advisor of the Year will appear in the first newsletter following the state conference.
2. Nominations will be submitted in writing to the District Director prior to an announced District Board meeting of the new calendar year.
3. Nominations should originate with students.
4. Letters of recommendation from the Student Council President and the Principal should accompany the nomination form.
5. Letters of recommendation should demonstrate the nominee's commitment to students, student organizations, and the school program.
6. Advisors must have at least **three (3) years** of student government experience.
7. The District 10 Advisor of the Year is ineligible for nomination in the calendar year following his/her recognition.
8. Selection of the Advisor of the Year will take place at a District Board meeting. Each board member school present will have one vote in the process.
9. The announcement and recognition of the Advisor of the Year will occur at the annual spring conference.
